Course Description:

This class will cover Awareness, Operations & Technician rope rescue techniques as required to meet NFPA 1006. Students shall be physically capable of performing and demonstrating the skills required for meeting NFPA 1006. Skills included but not limited to knot tying, use of various rope rescue devices, self-lowering, lifting and lowering loads, multiple descent devices, mechanical advantage systems, PT packaging and stokes basket operations.

Equipment / Materials Needed for this class:

- Climate and Weather appropriate clothing. (Rain or shine we train)
- Leather lace-up boots that provide ankle support
- Personal gear may be used, but must pass instructor inspection and be marked (Rope gloves not fire gloves, rope helmet and rescue harness)
- R. Lipke Technical Rescue Riggers Guide (Recommended only)
